

Benches and Pavers may be requested throughout the year, although we will only be purchasing every spring for placement to take place during the summer months

Commemorative Bench

Commemorative benches allow visitors to sit and enjoy their surroundings and funds raised from the program help support TWC's mission of connecting our community to conservation through education.



Commemorative benches may be requested of donors for \$2,500 or greater. For more information about our Benches Program, visit wildernesscenter.org

- Bench location will be mutually agreed upon.
- Benches can be personalized with a message of the donor's choosing (size is limited).

Written confirmation will follow after the bench installation is complete and will include the location and picture of the bench. If the donor wishes, a card of acknowledgement can be sent to the recipient's family advising that their loved one has been honored or commemorated in this special way.

Commemorative benches will be maintained by TWC for a maximum of 10 years (at no cost to the donor). At the 10 year mark the donor will have first right of option to renew the bench with a new tribute gift or refuse and the bench will be up for rededication for another donor once repairs are needed or the bench is no longer usable.

Memorial Pavers

Our Memorial Pavers are permanently placed around the Interpretive Building, the path to the Astronomy Building or in the seating area of Nature Playscape. The donor and TWC will mutually agree on placement on paver.



Pavers are \$300 for an 8x4 brick that is engraved with up to 3 lines of text. Each line may include up to 20 characters including punctuation.

Confirmation and picture of paver will be provided once the paver is placed.

Cards of acknowledgement can be sent to the recipient's family advising of them that their loved one has been honored or commemorated in this special way.
