Rules of the Trail

- Fires & charcoal grills are **not** permitted.
- Hunting, fishing, swimming, trapping, or overnight camping is **prohibited**.
- Do **not** pick flowers or collect plants or animals.
- Vehicles, bicycles, and horses are **not** permitted on the trails.
- Do **not** consume alcoholic beverages or illegal substances on the property.
- Stay on the trails.
- Leave at dusk.
- Pets are **not** permitted on Zoar Woods trail.
- Supervise children at all times.
- Have courtesy for other visitors.
- Help keep Zoar Woods safe, clean, and quiet.


