- 🍃 Do **not** pick flowers or collect plants or animals.
- 🍃 Vehicles, bicycles, and horses are **not** permitted on the trails.
- 🍃 Do **not** consume alcoholic beverages or illegal substances on the property.
- 🍃 Stay on the trails.
- 🍃 Leave at sunset.
- 🍃 Supervise children at all times.
- 🍃 Have courtesy for other visitors.
- 🍃 Help keep Doughty Gorge safe, clean, and quiet.
- 🍃 Leashed pets are permitted.

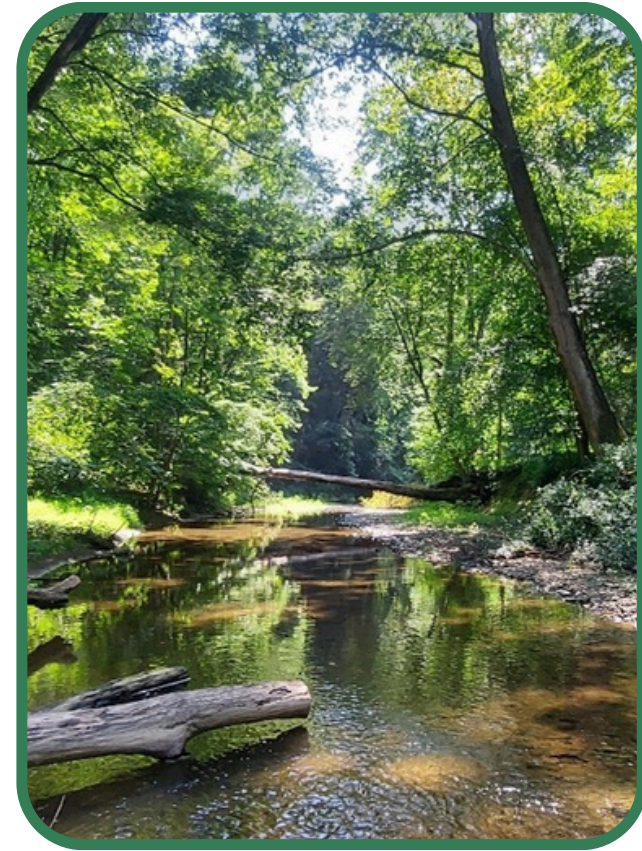

## About...

Doughty Gorge is a 93-acre preserve located near Charm, OH in Holmes County and is one of The Wilderness Center's most pristine habitats across all our landholdings. Filled with mature eastern hemlock, white oak, and American beech in the overstory, nearly 160 plant species and 41 fish species have been identified at this truly exquisite property.

## Driving Directions from TWC

Take US 62 W through Wilmot, Winesburg, and Berlin. Take a right at Main St in Berlin, then a left at Market St. Follow until intersection with stop sign, then take a left on OH 557.

Follow OH 557 for 1.4 miles, past Guggisberg Cheese. Turn right at Township Rd 154 - Doughty Gorge is on your right in ½ mile.

## Gate Information

There is an unlocked cable looped around the right pole. Simply lift the cable and set it aside. Drive through to parking area. When finished, please loop the cable back on the pole.
